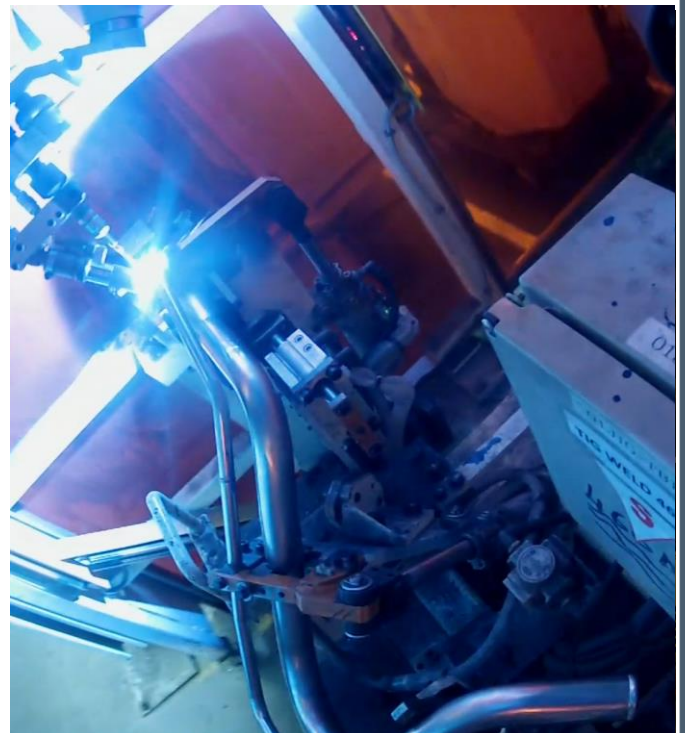
FMUK is the UK division of Futaba Corporation a 17Bn Yen revenue Japanese conglomerate. CDM services as Principal Designer and Principal Contractor on a project to install Kawasaki automated production facilities at Futaba Industrial UK, Tier 1 supplier to Honda, Jaguar Land Rover and Toyota for the manufacture and supply of fuel systems. Develop and issue pre-construction information and construction phase plan. Project Management and Site Supervision including mobilisation to setup the CDM site within on-going operational factory integrating of project schedule to manufacturing schedule to ensure business continuity. Works included all documentation to make the CDM site legally compliant, and compilation of the HSE file. 13,000-man hours worked with zero accidents/incidents and two near misses in a high hazard environment. We proactively pursue near misses to embed a positive safety culture within our projects. Specific challenges: HV Electrical, complex and heavy lifting, pipework installations and pressure testing, working at height, all whilst working in an active factory with 200+ staff and intense fast paced Just In Time (JIT) internal logistic operations.
