Pentagon Assurance LTD was asked by JDR cables to provide assurance systems support to embed explosive atmospheres (ATEX) protections into the design and manufacture of subsea cable reelers. Embedding the necessary ATEX standards to ISO requirements required a project led approach engaging a broad spectrum of stakeholders across the business to identify a broad ranging failure, mode, effect analysis (FMEA) against the relevant ISO standards. Pentagon then implemented remedial measures to address the identified gaps with the client team. The project took 7 weeks to complete including compilation of evidence to achieve third party accreditation
